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## Warburg's Atlas of Memory: *Mnemosyne*

### Inspiring concepts:

- Mapping cultural memory through images
- Expressing semantics through intertextual links between images

### Utopia:

- wooden panels only allow to express poor links between items
- Individual curation of a specialist (positive factor for originality, negative factor for a shared vision)

### Civic epistemologies:

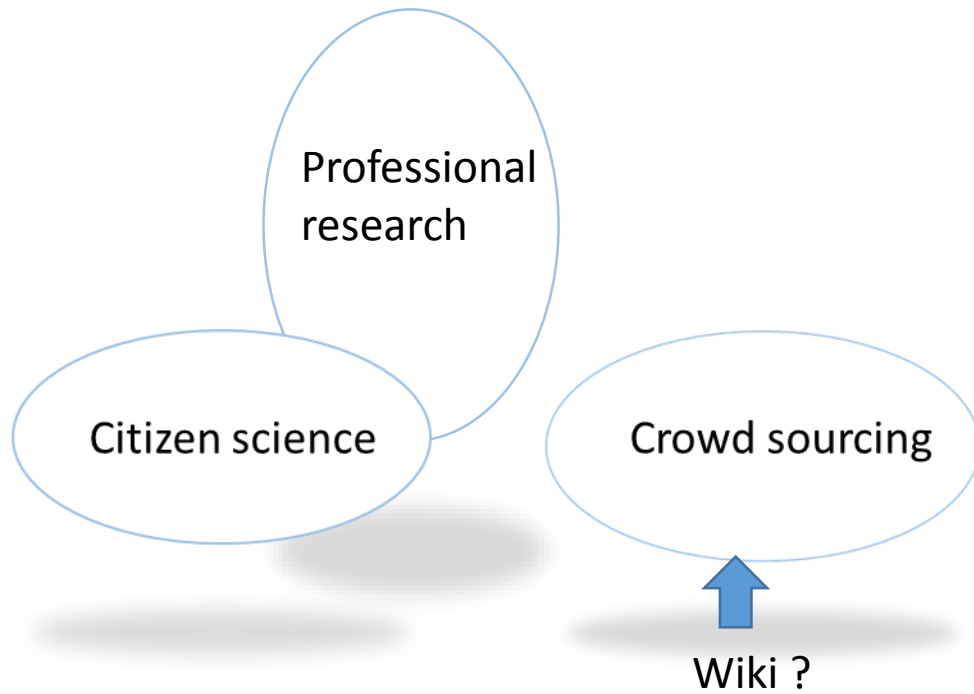
a contemporary agenda for mapping culture

- The **semantic web** allows us to modulate a multidimensional network of items, in which every item potentially is the central node of a network of knowledge
- **Collective curation** of cultural memory brings specialists and citizen scientists into interaction
- Shared curation of culture increases **social cohesion** and may help for the creation of new economic opportunities

## Hybridisation in the curation of culture

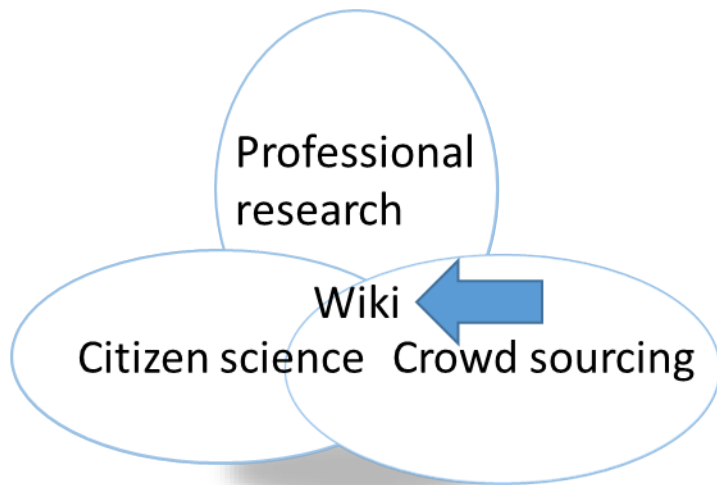
- Top-down (research) + bottom-up (citizens' engagement) → something new
- The 'democratic challenge' : governing COMPLEXITY
- crowd-sourcing meets citizen science → towards expert sourcing?

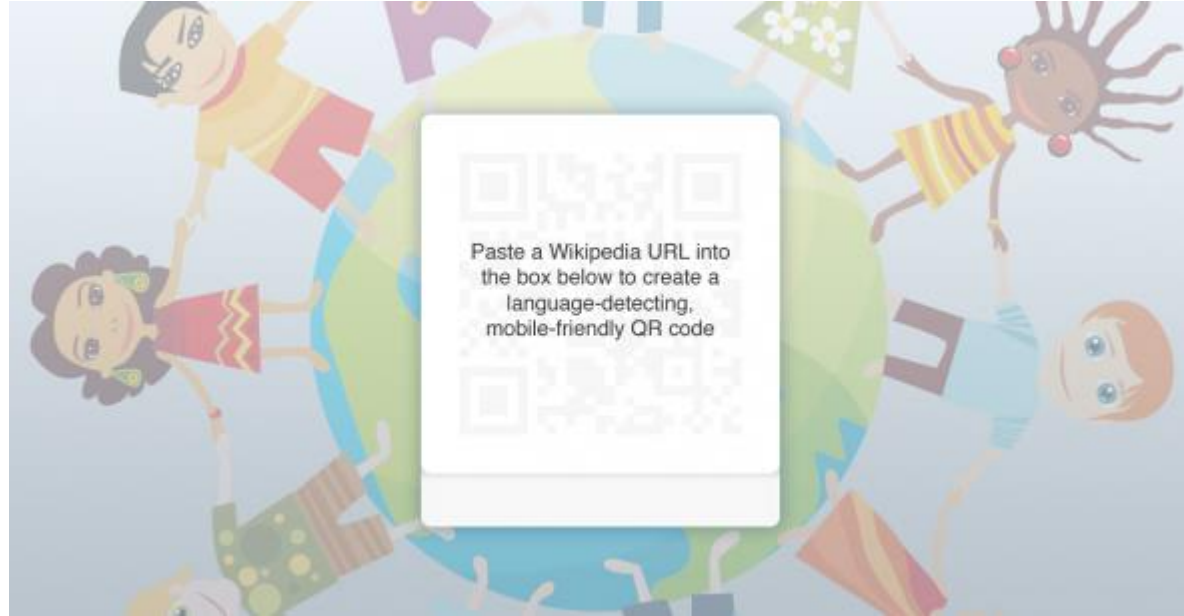
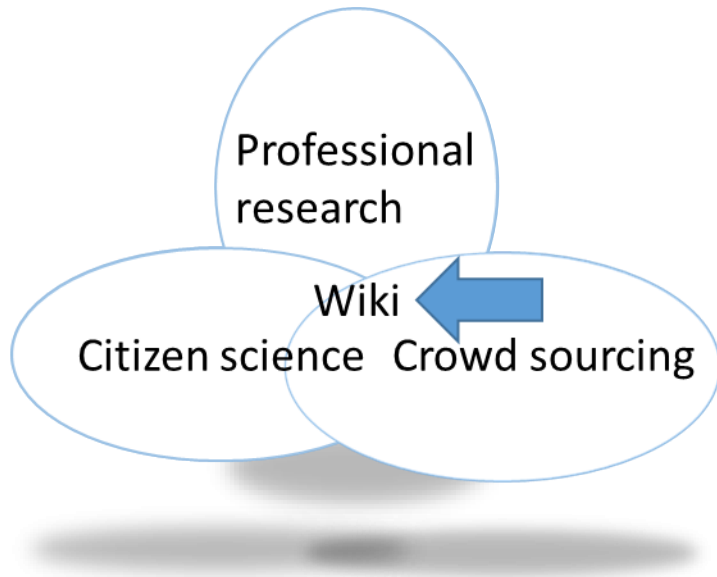


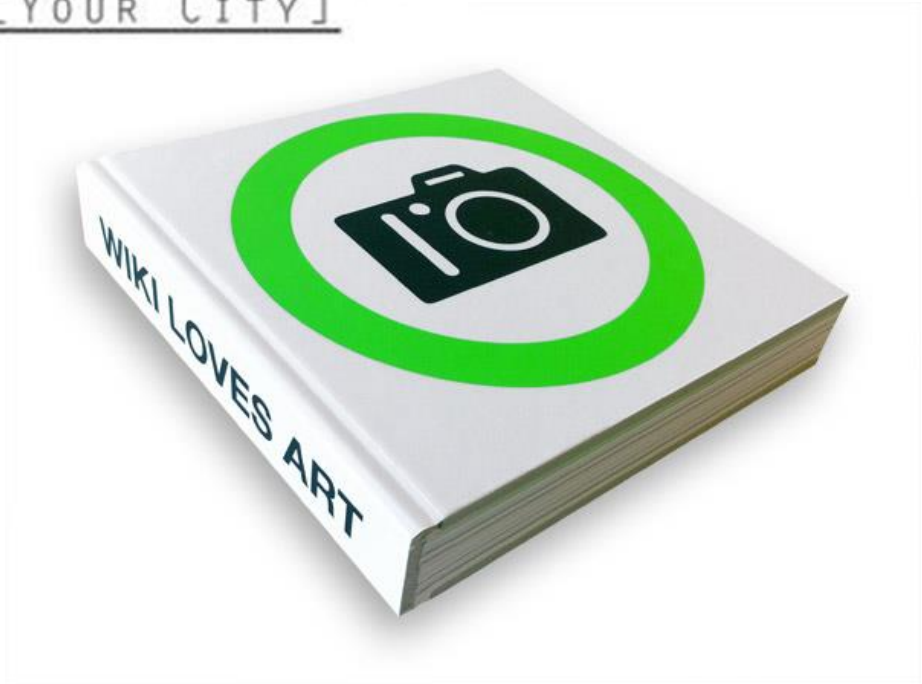
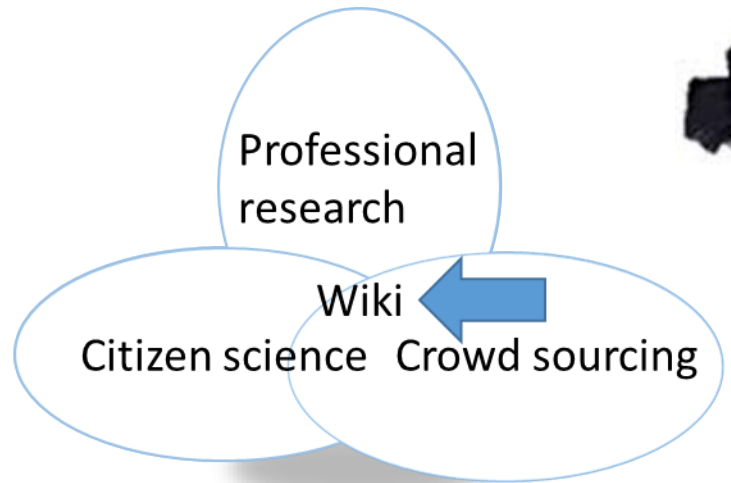


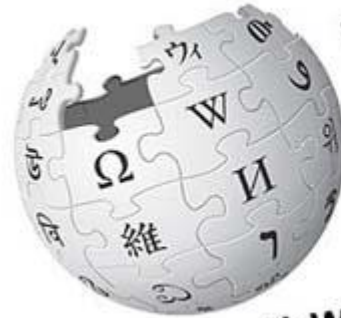
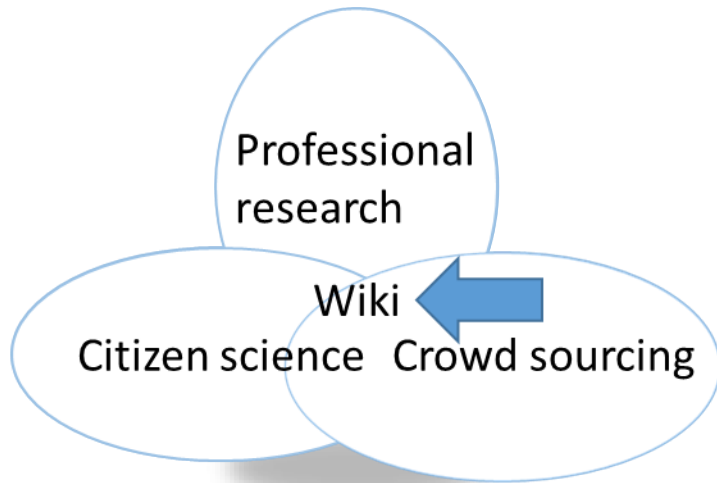

1. A coordinator of projects that strengthen partnerships between museums and Wikipedia.

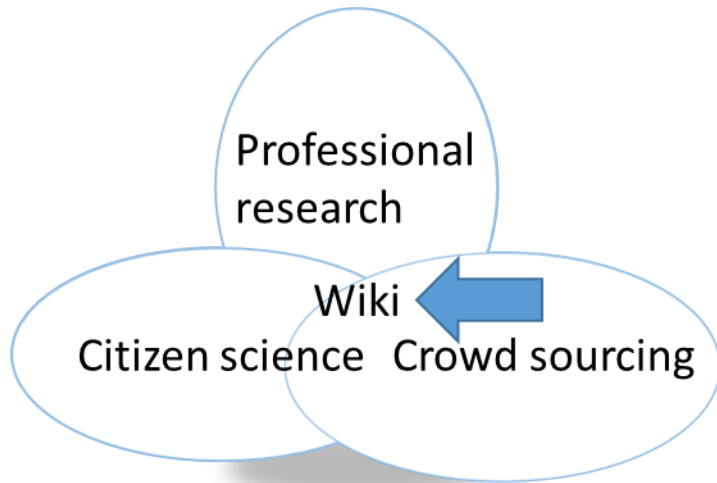

- 464** Wikipedia articles updated during residencies

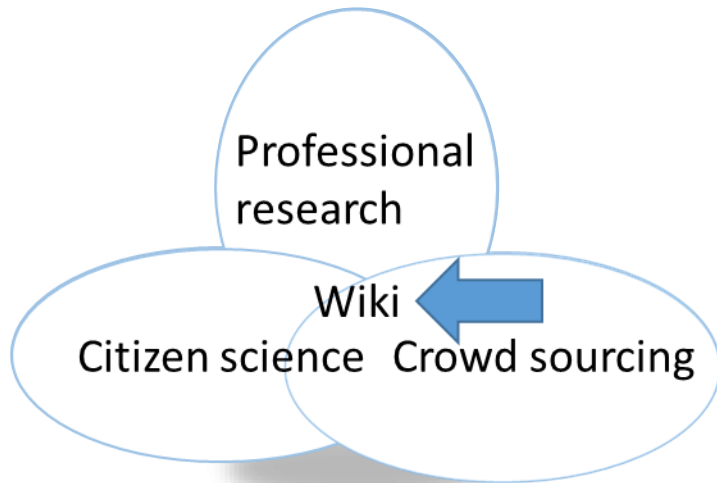
